### Scholarship Awards

Scholarships are renewable for 1 year with the stipulation of a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and the student is properly enrolled as a full-time student in the next term or session.

### Award Selection Process

The scholarship committee will review application and select without bias the most qualified and deserving scholarship applicant. Although a minimum grade point average has been established as criteria, the higher GPA will not be the primary determining factor in the selection process. The applicant's leadership and extracurricular involvement will be carefully considered and weighed heavily in the selection process. The scholarship recipient will receive a confirmation letter with directions on claiming the scholarship. The scholarship amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ will be sent as a one-time payment directly to the financial aid office of the recipient's school.

### Application:

The application must include the following items to be considered complete:

1. Completed and signed application form.
2. Essay addressing the following questions (300 to 500 words):
  - a. What is your intended career choice?
  - b. Who or what in your life has influenced you most regarding your career choice?
  - c. What are your career goals?
3. Two letters of recommendation. These should address their knowledge of your character, leadership responsibilities

fulfilled, academic / athletic accomplishments and community involvement.

4. College or High School transcript or school officials' verification.

### Eligibility

Students or their parent (guardian) or grandparent must be a veteran. The student should exhibit leadership potential, initiative and have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and enrolled as a full-time student. In all other respects, these funds shall be awarded without restriction to sex, race, color, handicap religion or national origin.

Completed applications must be received at the Charles Earnest Scott, American Legion Post 47 in Dodge City Kansas, on or before 5:00 p.m, May 15, 2023.
